

Administration and Consequences

Please read the "Expectations" document prior to reading this document.

1. Per school district policy, cell phones, ipods, and other electronic devices are not allowed to be on during class time.

- a. Any such devices visible to the instructor during class time will be taken from the student and forwarded to the school administration.
- b. If the student refuses to give the device to the instructor, the student will immediately be referred to the school administration.
- c. If a device is taken from a student a second time the device will be forwarded to the school administration and the student will receive 3 days detention. It will be the student's responsibility to notify the parent of detention. The teacher will notify the parent if the student fails to attend detention.

2. Students are expected to give their attention to instruction and assignments during class time.

- a. The minimum acceptable grade for this course is a 70. Students who fail to perform to that standard during normal class hours will be assigned instructional detention daily until the work meets that standard.
- b. Grading is as follows
 - i. Performance and Participation 30%
 - ii. Classwork and homework 50%
 - iii. Chapter Tests 5%
 - iv. Unit Tests 15%
- c. Parents will be contacted during the first week of school for verification of home phone numbers, email addresses, and information about RISD's "Parent Connect, an online method of viewing your student's grades and contacting teachers via email.
- d. Students whose behavior is unacceptable in class will first have their parents notified for a parent conference, Second events, or inability to contact a parent will result in a student being referred immediately to the office.

3. School Absences

- a. All chapter activities and materials are available on this website except chapter and unit tests. Students are responsible for obtaining makeup work either from the website or from the instructor. Students have one day of makeup time for each day of excused absence.
